MATERIALS LIST

watercolor

All materials can be purchased at Townsend Atelier in our store. Students enrolled in the class will receive a 20% discount on everything excluding brushes.

If you already have supplies you like to use, feel free to bring those. This is a recommended list, not requirements.

- **Palette** a good covered plastic palette (such as Aquapro, Robert E. Wood or John Pike). Otherwise, a plastic palette with plenty of space for mixing and adding colors.
- **Watercolor Paper** Arches 140 lb cold press paper.
A 10 x 14 block or you can purchase 2 sheets that can be cut into smaller sizes.
You will need to bring a sheet of foamboard or plexiglass to tape the paper down.
- **Paints**- Buy professional quality (Artist not student) paints. You will use less paint and get better results. Townsend Atelier sells M Graham paints.
Buy the smaller tubes to start.
- **Basic paints:**
 - Aureolin or Lemon Yellow
 - New Gamboge or Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Permanent Red or Quinacridone Red
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Cobalt Blue
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Sap Green
 - Burnt Sienna**Extras that will give you more of a range:**
 - Cerulean Blue
 - Raw Sienna
 - Viridian
 - Burnt Umber
 - Cadmium Orange
 - Permanent Rose
 - Cobalt Violet

- **Brushes-** White Sable, Squirrel, or Synthetics are OK. #6 or #8 round; #10 or #12 round; one 1" or 2" flat. Townsend Atelier sells Rosemary brand brushes
- **Sketchbook-** 8 x 10 or 9 x 12; mechanical pencil, kneaded eraser, Viva paper towels, water spray bottle.

A plastic paint bucket (1 qt or larger) for water will be provided for use in class.
