Materials list for:

5 Day Beginner's Bootcamp

Materials may be purchased prior to or during class. Students will receive a 20% discount on everything excluding brushes.

NOTE: We will be going over all painting materials on the first day of class, so if you feel lost, just wait to buy your supplies on the first day of class and Mia will help you!

Oils:

I recommend M. Graham paints available at Townsend Atelier, however any brand is fine.

Titanium White

Ivory Black

Cadmium red light

Cobalt Blue (hues are fine)

Cadmium Lemon Yellow (Or Azo or Hansa Yellow) (Hues are fine)

Palette:

Please DO NOT bring white plastic or paper palettes. If you are using plastic or paper, please use GRAY. Wood and glass are welcome, and there is also a limited range of wooden palettes at Townsend Atelier available for students to use for free.

Supports:

One pad of canvas paper size 12"x16"

Brushes:

I recommend Rosemary Brushes available at Townsend Atelier.

Please bring a small variety of flat, round, and filbert brushes ranging in size and texture. I like to have a few Mongoose brushes, and a few good bristle synthetics. (Again, I will go over this in class, so please don't worry or scramble!)

Solvent: Please use ODORLESS mineral Spirits in a container that can be closed tightly. I recommend using a Silicoil jar or a metal jar specifically for solvents.

Also bring:

*Paper towels

*Hand- held mirror

*Tupperware and Saran Wrap for any extra paint you may want to bring home

*Sketchbook and paper for notes

*roll of masking tape (try to buy the cream/off white kind, not blue or a bright color)

*Latex or nitrile gloves
