

Materials List Learning to Draw | Rafferty

*Materials can be purchased in Townsend Atelier prior to or during class.
Students in the class will receive a 20% discount on all materials.*

A selection of **drawing pencils from 4H to 8B** (Winsor & Newton's are nicely color coded so its easy to pick up the right pencil but any brand is fine)

Paper of your choice:

1. Strathmore 400 series drawing paper, 11x14 preferred but 9x12 ok
2. Strathmore Bristol Smooth, 11x14 preferred but 9x12 ok

Erasers: one kneaded eraser

White eraser such as Staedtler Mars Plastic or Prismacolor Magic Rub

Mechanical pencil style eraser such as Tombow Mono Zero Refillable or General's

Factis Mechanical (optional)

Drawing board - I prefer a foam core board (available at any craft store or office supply store), at least 14x18, but traditional hardboard or any other very smooth surface is fine.

Pencil sharpener - ideally one that will catch the shavings; I prefer the Long Point versions if available.

Helpful but not required:

a straight-edge (ruler or other)

sketchbook or loose paper to do homework and general practice - choose a sketch book with smooth paper! For practice, printer paper works well.
