SUPPLY LIST

Materials can be purchased prior to or during the workshop at Townsend Atelier's store. Students will receive a 20% discount on everything excluding brushes. We carry M Graham oil paints and Rosemary Brushes

Bring:

- 3 natural objects: fruit, vegetables, leaves, flowers, bones, etc.
- 2 manmade objects: vases, cups, bowls, trinkets, toys, etc.
- 2 pieces of cloth: any color

Below are the materials I use and recommend. You may have similar supplies that are suitable. Feel free to contact me at christinaweaverartist@gmail.com with any questions.

OIL PAINTS & MEDIUM

(You may use any brand you like. Instructor uses Gamblin Artist Grade Oil Colors or Winsor & Newton Artist's Oil Colors (not water mixable)

37 ml tubes:

- Titanium White
- Alizarin Crimson
- Cadmium Red Light
- India Yellow
- Cadmium Yellow Medium
- Cadmium Lemon
- Phthalo Turquoise
- Ultramarine Blue / French Ultramarine

Gamblin Solvent-Free Medium (gel or liquid)

BRUSHES & KNIVES

- 3" trowel-shaped palette knife, metal
- Princeton Dakota Series 6300* synthetic bristle brushes:
 - 3 *Flat*, sizes 2, 4, 6
 - 3 *Filbert*, sizes 2, 4, 6

PALETTE

My palette is a piece of glass on top of white mat board, backed by a piece of wood. 11 x 14" is a good size for travel. The layers are wrapped together around the edges with duct tape. Reinforce and bubble wrap palette before transport.

PAINTING SURFACES

Bring one *prepared* canvas or panel, roughly 16 x 20".

I encourage you to make your own painting substrate. Oil-primed linen, oil-primed canvas, and oil-primed wood are ideal. *Size* your stretched fabric / surface of choice with PVA or acrylic gesso. Then apply 2 or 3 thin coats of Gamblin oil ground with a disposable bristle brush. Sand lightly after each application and allow a week of drying time before oil painting. If acrylic primer is used, I recommend Golden Gesso.

SOLVENT

Gamsol

2 non-glass containers with tight-fitting lids

OTHER SUPPLIES

Ruler

Razor scraper

Paper towels or cotton rags (bring plenty)

Grocery bags for trash

The atelier has plenty of easels and taborets for your use.
